Slip-On platforms are simple to install because all you do is slide them onto the forklift, lock them into position and they are set to work. Slip-on style attachments have gained huge popularity as they are quick and easy to operate. They offer an inexpensive answer for businesses who do not require them often. These platforms have a railing system in position, skid proof decking and tie offs accessible. They still require the use of safety equipment by employees but come with these particular features to be able to further the safety of people who will be using them. Slip-on work platforms are an excellent alternative for those projects that take place in difficult places or over top of an object.

A pin system fastens this sort of platform onto your lift truck after sliding the platform on. The industrial lift stand provides extra protection because they are equipped with a safety screen in the back and railings on three sides. For extra safety, it is a great idea to consider choosing a style which opens through the front barrier instead of the side gate model.

Stock pickers can mount onto a lift truck with the same foundations as the other platforms though they are rather different. Stock pickers have a smaller base surrounded by barrier on three sides and its guard screen is located on the front. This model differs from the other platforms for the reason that the cage and the surface do not take up the entire fork surface area.

Combination platforms have proven to be extremely helpful when workers must work with supplies a height. This particular kind of platform has a smaller and larger section. This design is significant so that employees can accomplish their job and not have to worry themselves about any supplies sliding onto them if the person operating it tips or tilts the objects.

There are lots of attachments presented that could attach to your platform that will improve its efficiency a lot more. For larger supply items such as piping, tall racks can be outfitted with guardrails. These racks keep supplies such as brooms, pipes as well as various objects from falling off of the platform and hitting other employees. For extra proficiency, there are tools, toolboxes and trays made to attach directly onto the side of the guardrails.
