

Side Tilt Carriage

Side Tilt Carriage - Rated by the fork carriage lifting capacity, there are four sizings of hook type fork carriages. The hook type fork carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing used for Class 1 is something like thirteen inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to carry cargo as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of sixteen inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo as much as 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for loads as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing used for this capacity is twenty five inches.

The carriages for pin type blades may be different depending on the manufacturer. Pin mounted tines can vary by the amount of offset between the tine eye and the fork. Carriage capacity would be determined by the carriage pin size and by the tine size.
