Cascade Clamps - Established in Portland, Oregon in the year 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine shop hiring just four people. Total sales for that year amounted to about \$60,000. The first recorded sales revenues involved the machining and assembly of stainless steel valves, pipe fittings and various parts. Throughout 5 years of operation, the company had expanded to forty employees and their yearly sales volume had increased to \$330,000. Today, Cascade is amongst the top global manufacturers within the material handling trade.

Production and design of the company's first hydraulic cylinder paved the way in Cascade's aggressive pursuit of better business opportunities. Over the past 60 years, the material handling trade has matured into a highly sophisticated field and Cascade has proudly played a part in this development. Cascade at present continues to develop as the premier supplier of forklift accessories and numerous related items. The company feels confident in their potential in order to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding buyer's requirements in the future and remaining competitive in the global market.

Through the nineteen fifties, Cascade began to manufacture, design, and promote its hydraulic accessories. A brand new facility was made in 1956, in order to accommodate all of the plant offices and operations in Portland, Oregon, which continues to be the company's current center of operations. Following 15 years of business, total employees reached a hundred and eighty staff and sales had reached practically 2.3 million dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Ohio a second production facility was built. 1960 marked Cascade's initial transfer into the global world of the material handling industry as the company established interest in England, Australia, and the Netherlands.

The business changed its name to Cascade Corporation in 1964. In the year 1965, Cascade went public with an initial offering of two hundred thousand shares of common stock. The company has expanded its manufacturing facilities within the United States with areas in Springfield, Ohio, Warner Robins, Georgia, Portland, Oregon. Cascade products are fabricated globally due to a lot of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new plant was accomplished in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This facility is made to be the ultimate customer support centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and 1997 with the impressive acquisition of five corporations, including the international best in blades, the Kenhar Corporation.
